

CO-FUNDING, OPEN ACCESS AND CONTENT REUSE POLICY

AGER applies a co-funding policy only to articles accepted for publication that acknowledge public or private funding received for their preparation. In such cases, a fee of **€150.00** will be charged to cover layout and publication costs.

However, the Editorial Board accepts exceptions, for example where the funding is intended for predoctoral training. In such cases, no fee is charged. Likewise, if an author has received funding but asks for the resulting publication not to include any reference to the research project from which that funding was obtained (usually stated in the “Acknowledgements” section), publication will once again be entirely free of charge.

In all cases, AGER covers the full cost of articles that do not acknowledge any source of funding.

Submission of an article implies acceptance of the applicable fee, which must be paid before publication.

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Authors whose contributions are accepted for publication in this journal will retain the non-exclusive right to use them for academic, research, and educational purposes, including self-archiving or depositing them in open-access repositories of any kind.

Preferably, the published version of the scholarly contributions (the publisher's post-print version) may be used or, failing that, the author's peer-reviewed and accepted post-print version. These versions will be made openly accessible as soon as possible, as the journal imposes no embargo period.

AGER also states that neither the review or publication of articles nor membership of any of the journal's bodies confers any right to remuneration.
