

CO-FINANCING POLICY, OPEN ACCESS AND RE-USE OF CONTENT

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However, the Editorial Board accepts exceptions, e.g. when the funding is for pre-doctoral training. In this case, no fee is required. Similarly, if the author, despite having received funding, refuses to include any reference in the publication to the research project from which the funding was obtained (usually indicated in the 'Acknowledgements' section), the publication is once again completely free of charge.

In any case, AGER covers the full cost of those articles that do not reflect any funding.

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AGER also states that neither the evaluation or publication of articles, nor membership of any of the journal's bodies will entitle the author to any remuneration.
